Requirements

- Ability to maintain a SECRET security clearance; US Citizenship required.
- Basic understanding of industrial U.S. Navy ship repair activities, to include hot work operations, work in confined spaces, fire prevention, and damage control efforts.
- Extensive and thorough understanding of U.S. Navy ship layout, configuration, and firefighting/damage control plates, placards, markings, and symbols.
- Detailed knowledge of U.S. Navy shipboard damage control equipment, firefighting principles, risk assessment, and ship's systems and equipment.
- A willingness to learn OSHA requirements and safety best practices.

- OSHA and/or Safety experience in the context of ship operations or ship building/repair.
- Understanding of ship systems related to firefighting, communications, and alarms, including proper lineups and functionality.
