

Fuels Maintenance Technician

Gideon USA is seeking a Fuels Maintenance Technician to perform Repairs to fuel systems for Department of Defense military installations, both CONUS and OCONUS.

Duties include but not limited to:

Repair, calibrate, and maintain liquid fuel storage, distribution, and dispensing systems.

- · Isolate tanks, pipelines and other components of fuel systems;
- · Replace valves, filters, pumps and other system components;
- · Maintenance and repair of control valves, both automatic and manual;
- Repair fuel tanks including welding repairs, installation of patch plates, installation of nozzles and manways, installation of stilling wells, installation of vents and related repairs;
- · Perform pressure testing of pipelines;
- · Place tanks and pipelines back in service;
- Utilize system drawings and schematics;
- · Operate equipment to provide testing, calibration, measurements;
- Prepare cost estimate for repairs and minor construction projects;
- · Plan and schedule work.

Knowledge, skills, and ability in the following:

- · Knowledge of DoD fuel system functionality and methods including equipment and materials used in construction and repair;
- · Principals of hydraulic, electrical, and mechanical theory as the apply to liquid fuel systems;
- Ability to understand complex layout drawings, schematics, diagrams, and analysis of construction and operational characteristics;
- · Use an interpretation of wiring diagrams, schematics, line drawings, and blue prints;
- Regulations and construction specifications and standards used in construction and repair of DoD fuels facilities as well as related construction inspection;
- · Inspection techniques related to DoD fuel facilities;
- · Interpersonal skills using tact, patience, and courtesy;
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships;
- · Ability to communicate effectively, both written and oral;
- · Work with minimal supervision;
- · Read, interpret, apply, and explain rules, regulations, policies, and procedures;
- Work outdoors in adverse weather conditions;
- · Maintain records and prepare reports.

Training, experience, and other requirements:

- Minimum 5 years' experience in fuel system operations and maintenance to include fuel storage facilities, pipelines, dispensing, and bulk refueling;
- · OSHA 30-hour and USACE Quality Control Certification preferred;
- Must have a valid drivers' license and US passport and be able to obtain a US DoD Common Access Card (CAC) and pass a US military background check;
- Considerable travel is required.
