Insect Detection Specialist IIs are responsible for performing detection, trapping, field identification, and control work on agricultural pests. Under general supervision, incumbents independently perform a variety of field and laboratory support duties and provide training to lower level Insect Detection Specialists.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

1. One (1) year of experience in the areas of vertebrate, insect, plant disease or weed detection and/or identification in a nursery, horticulture or agricultural setting; **OR**,

2. Completion of at least eighteen (18) units of college level course work from an accredited U.S. college or university, or a certified foreign studies equivalency in biology, botany, entomology, or a closely related science; **OR**,
3. Six (6) months of experience as an Insect Detection Specialist I in the County of San Diego, or equivalent pest detection experience with other counties or California Department of Food and Agriculture.

If you are attempting to qualify under Minimum Qualification #2, then please attach a copy of your college documents (diploma, complete official/unofficial transcripts, foreign equivalency certificate, or letter of verification) during Step 1 of the application submittal process.
