Material Readiness Assessment Team Lead

Lead a team in Navy shipboard system material readiness data collection, validation, and processing to develop material readiness metrics related to reliability, maintainability, availability, supportability, and cost. Analyze data to gauge ship material condition and mission capability for in-service combat systems, C5I systems, and hull, mechanical, and electrical (HM&E) systems and identify causes of readiness impacts. Develop system reliability models and compare predicted reliability to actual values. Perform diagnostic and predictive analyses to identify and verify the efficacy of readiness-based improvements and corrective actions such as maintenance procedures, training, parts sparing, logistics support plans, distance support, and tech-assist visits. Identify readiness trends and drivers, support readiness trade-off decisions, and measure effectiveness of corrective actions. Analyze potential system upgrades, Engineering Change Proposals, Ordnance Alterations, and future system designs to predict readiness impacts based on in-service system data. Leadership duties will include interface with customers and stakeholders, definition of work performance requirements, development of work execution plans, development of schedules and budgets, communication of expectations to team members, performance of technical work execution, monitoring work progress, and assurance of quality in services and products delivered.
