- Coordinate job applications and interviews for JCEP participants with local employers.
- Provide documentation of program success through articles, emails, pictures, and participant/employer interviews.
- Follow up with participants once they are employed to ensure that employment data is captured and ask that surveys be completed.

The JCEP Training & Development Specialists/ Case Managers (TDS/CM) shall have at a minimum a Baccalaureate degree, or with at least 5 years work experience. Appropriate supervisory and military experience is strongly recommended.
